## **CLASS SPLITS**

As per PBSA policy, all efforts will be made to provide class splits designed to improve competition. The race committee will use criteria other than ratings to decide class splits. All one-design classes that register seven or more boats before the close of the Open Entry Period will have separate one-design scoring, and possible one-design starts\*.

\*Race management reserves the right to require one-design fleet captains. It will be the responsibility of these individuals to insure the boats in their respective fleets are equipped and sailed in strict accordance with all applicable class standards. Additionally, certain classes may be required to provide a dedicated chase boat as a prerequisite to participation.

## **ENTRIES & ENTERING**

Whitebread XVI is open to any conventional yacht with a corrected PHRF rating of 300 or less, and multihulls of 16' or greater.

The race committee reserves the right to excuse any yacht whose characteristics may compromise the integrity of the racing classes or any yachts that may be deemed unsafe.

- Rating Certificate or day rating application

## **RATING CERTIFICATE**

Each boat shall submit a valid rating certificate from PHRF of Eastern Long Island, or a completed Temporary day rating application,
